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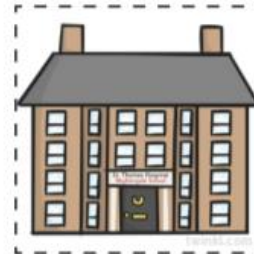
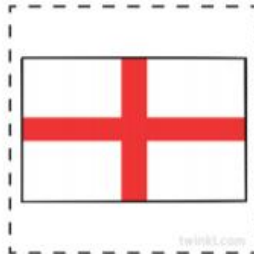


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Florence Nightingale was born on the 12th of May.
