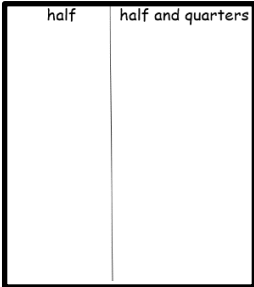

Phonics: This week we are learning all about contractions. Can you remember what a contraction is? Maths: Learning Objective: To find one half and one quarter of a shape. Today we are going to learn about fractions and find half and quarter of shapes. Listen to the PowerPoint in the folder to find out what a fraction is and how we can find half and quarter of a shape. Then print and carefully cut out the shape pictures in the folder. Find out and sort which shapes can only be folded in half and which shapes can be folded in half and into quarters. Record your work like this by sticking your shapes onto the correct side: 	Maths: Learning Objective: To recognise a half.
