Go through the What Vegetable am I? PowerPoint. Can you guess the vegetable? Can you make up a riddle?	Literacy: Learning Objective: To make story characters. Starter: Listen to the story Supertato on the website. Activity: Make a Supertato and a Pea. You could draw them, paint them or collage them. Using your Supertato and Pea act out parts of the story or create your own scenarios.	Literacy: Learning Objective: To describe a character. Starter: Listen to the story Supertato on the website. Activity: Think about the scenarios you acted out yesterday. What were Supertato and Pea saying to each other. Fill in the speech bubbles on the worksheet provided. If you haven't got a printer, you could draw speech bubbles and add them to your work from yesterday. Send a photo of your completed work to your class teacher by Friday.	Maths: Learning Objective: To talk about capacity. Starter: Read and listen to the PowerPoint on capacity. Activity: Explore capacity. Using water and various containers, can you fill them so they are full, half full and empty. Can you talk about capacity using the words full, empty, half full? Extension: Can you fill them to nearly empty and nearly full?	Maths: Learning Objective: To order by capacity. Starter: Read and listen to the PowerPoint on capacity. Activity: Find 3 cups the same size, fill them one to full, one to half full and one empty. Can you place them in order from fullest to emptiest? Repeat with 5 cups and add nearly full and nearly empty and place them in order. Extension: Find some containers of different sizes, count how many cups of water it takes to fill each one. Send a photo of your completed work to your class teacher by Friday.
