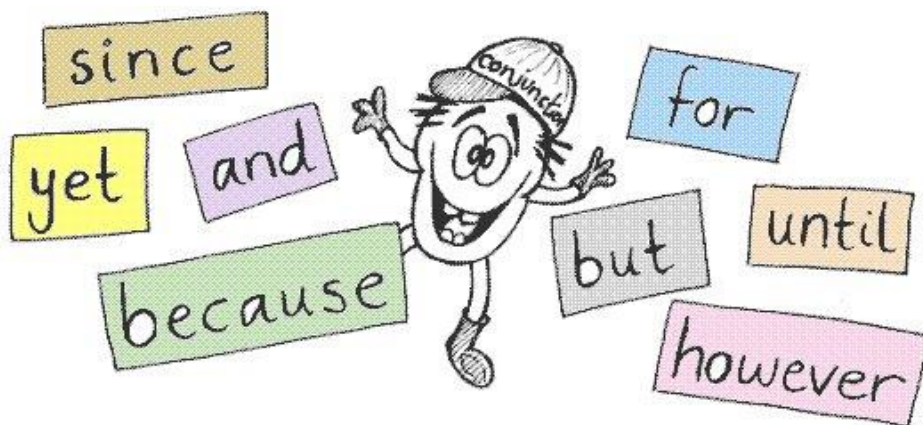


Join these two sentences together using a conjunction
